A beach hunt is planned at Zuma on the Saturday after the July meeting. Details will be upcoming.

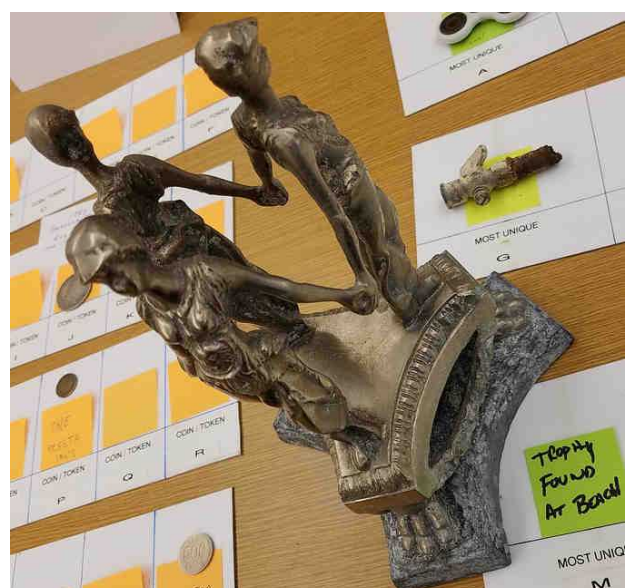
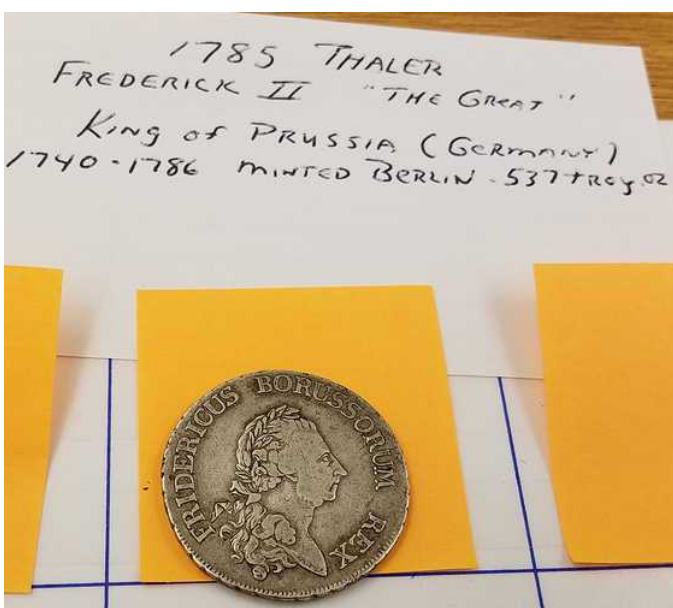
A beach barbecue will be held on Saturday, June 24. Details were discussed and will be emailed to members before the event. A planted hunt with prizes will be included.
